Call for Proposals - Database of Mozambican Companies from the Agro- Processing and Light Manufacturing Sectors

The International Trade Center (ITC) is the joint agency of the World Trade Organization (WTO) and the United Nations (UN). The ITC assists small and medium-sized enterprises in developing and transition economies to become more competitive in global markets, thereby contributing to sustainable economic development within the frameworks of the Aid-for-Trade agenda and the Sustainable Development Goals.

The ITC is the implementing agency of the Partnership for Investment and Growth in Africa (PIGA) program. Therefore, the PIGA program is supported by the Government of the United Kingdom (UK) of Great Britain and Northern Ireland's Department for International Development (DFID), China Council for the Promotion of International Trade (CCPIT), and by the China Africa Development Fund (CADFund).

Under this partnership, DFID, CCPIT, CADFund and ITC jointly aim to increase investment-led exports and local development in two productive sectors, **agro-processing** and **light manufacturing**, in Ethiopia, Kenya, Mozambique and Zambia.

In Mozambique, ITC is cooperating with the Agência para a Promoção de Investimento e Exportações (APIEX). ITC and APIEX are currently identifying Mozambican companies from the **agro-processing and/or light manufacturing** sector that have the capacity and are interested to explore Joint Ventures (**Particularly for Greenfield Projects**) with Chinese companies.
